



Land Use
 Neighboring land uses can affect the Study Area through the type of users, access needs and policing requirements. Land use adjacent to the Study Area is predominantly residential (yellow). Residential areas The only major exceptions to this trend are in the South Valley on the East Side of the river, where the primary use is industrial/vacant and near Central where the primary use is commercial and parks. In some other areas there are parks or other open space areas adjacent to the bosque, e.g. at Calabacillas Arroyo, the Rio Grande Nature Center, and the Alameda Wetland. The map data is derived from assessor parcel data for the year 2000.
