



Public & Private Land
 Most of the land within the Study Area is public land, owned by the MRGCD and managed by the AOSD. Along the west side of the river between Corrales and Central, there are some notable exceptions. The Oxbow Wetland is owned by city outright and is managed as a refuge. The bluffs above the wetland, as well as the land just south of Montano Bridge and the Corrales Bosque have conservation easements in place. The land north of Montano is currently privately owned down to the center of the river and the lands south of the Oxbow down through the central area are currently in dispute. Land ownership can negatively affect potential implementation of restoration strategies and subsequent management. Recreational access may be limited or outright eliminated. The map data is derived from assessor parcel data for the year 2000 with input from AOSD
